

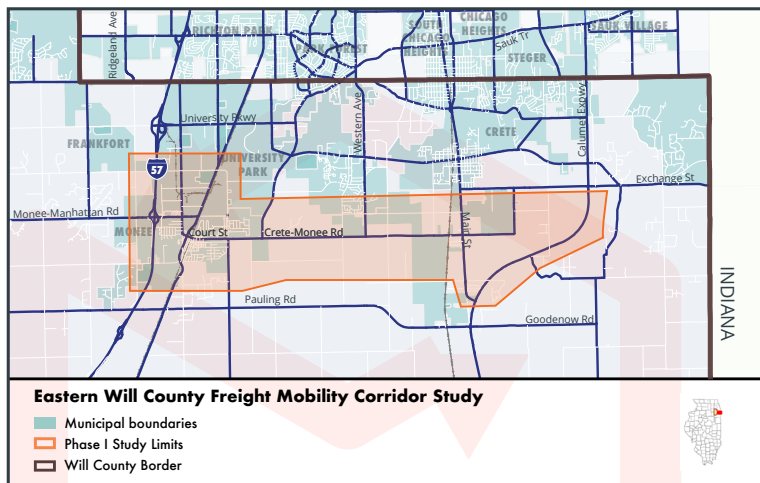
EASTERN WILL COUNTY FREIGHT MOBILITY CORRIDOR STUDY

The Will County Division of Transportation (DOT) invites you to participate in an upcoming open-house format public meeting to learn more about the Eastern Will County Freight Mobility Corridor Study.

Will County DOT is conducting a transportation mobility corridor study to identify ways to improve freight travel through Eastern Will County due to community concerns regarding growth in truck traffic from the high density and continuing influx of warehousing, distribution centers and associated freight activity.



The study area includes the following Will County municipalities:

- Crete
- Monee
- Parts of Frankfort and University Park

The study borders the Cook County municipalities of Richton Park and South Chicago Heights.

Any comment received between June 26, 2025 and July 24, 2025 in person, electronically or by mail will become part of the official public meeting record.
